



VMNL TEAM COACH POSITION DESCRIPTION

As a coach, you will be responsible for planning, organising and delivering a range of training and player development activities for one of the Victorian Men's or Mixed netball teams.

The Victorian Men's and Mixed Netball Squad participate in the annual AMMNA Championships. In 2018 this will be held in Sydney. As a Victorian coach, you will play a key role in preparing a team to compete in the championships, as well as travelling with the team and coaching throughout the tournament.

In the lead up to this competition, teams train weekly at Banyule Nets Stadium in Macleod, on Sunday morning.

Pre-Season Responsibilities:

- Selection of players for a team (or extended squad, in the case of reserve teams), either as part of a panel or solo;
- Attend all team training sessions
- Creating appropriate fitness programmes for your squad;
- Developing and delivering a training programme for your squad;
- Developing the skills of individual players within your squad;
- Selecting a leadership team within your squad;
- Where requested participate in the development of Men's and Mixed Netball via clinics or other channels as advised by the VMNL committee.
- Participate in all VMNL arranged specialised training/fitness sessions.

Touring Responsibilities:

- Attending AMMNA Championships;
- Making decisions regarding match tactics during a game;
- Providing a written report at the completion of the tournament.
- Ensure at all times, the team behaviour is appropriate in accordance with the VMNL and AMMNA Codes of Conduct and meets all dress code requirements
